Who can go? Any registered Boy or Varsity Scout. The camp will provide the adult leadership. You will need to arrange your own transportation.

Your first day is spent checking-in, deciding about advancement, and taking a swim test.

All meals are eaten in our dining hall and you will be living in a camp provided two-man tent with cots.

2009 Provisional Fees

The Basic week long experience is \$325 in council, \$335 for week out of council, OC adults \$160, non OC \$170.

Refund Policy

Because most of the camp fees are actually spent prior to your arrival in camp, refunds can only be made under the following conditions:

1. All cancellations must be made in writing and must be received at least two weeks prior to your arrival at camp.
2. No refunds can be made for cancellations received less than two weeks prior to your arrival. This also includes any "no shows" or Scout/Varsity Team members who leave during the week for any reason.
3. The only exception to this policy is in the case of an illness or injury verified in writing by a parent and/or guardian and a physician.

All refunds are subject to a 15% per registered person fee. All refunds should be requested prior to September 1, 2009.

Directions

From Orange County, take the Riverside (91) Freeway to Corona. In Corona, take Interstate 15 south past Lake Elsinore to Temecula. Exit on to Highway 79 South and turn left (the exit sign says "Indio" - DO NOT take Highway 79 North.) and continue on past Vail Lake, Aguanga, and Oak Grove. Follow Highway 79 south into San Diego County. Approximately 30 miles from Temecula is the turn off (left) to Chihuahua Valley Road. Proceed up into the valley for about six miles to the beginning of the Lost Valley Road. Our scenic dirt road goes straight ahead as the paved road makes a sharp right turn. It is about 11 miles to Lost Valley on this scenic dirt road. The 11-mile dirt road into camp is a one-way road and uphill traffic has the right of way. Keep your eyes open for on-coming traffic. Please use the turn-outs for on-coming and faster traffic, and please drive safely to and from camp.
