Climbing, Astronomy and Aviation

Merit Badge Weekend Program - October 9-11, 2009

Come as a troop, patrol or individual and join us for a fun-filled, rewarding weekend program. Boys sign up for one of the following merit badges: Climbing, Astronomy or Aviation. You will stay in one of the cabins (astronomy merit badge spends Saturday night at the observatory), have great food in Beckman dining hall, and a great program. The fees listed include camping fee, cabin use, food and program fees. Climbing participants must have a permission slip signed by their parent with them to participate. Individual Scouts must be accompanied by an adult. Each Scout may only sign up for one Merit Badge.

Climbing Merit Badge: Prerequisite requirements 1 and 2: Be prepared to discuss the following:

1a. Show that you know first aid for and how to prevent injuries or illnesses that could occur during climbing active ties, including heat and cold reactions, dehydration, stopped breathing, sprains, abrasions, fractures, rope burns, blisters, snakebite, and insect bites or stings.

1b. Identify the conditions that must exist before performing CPR on a person.

2. Learn the Leave No Trace principles and Outdoor Code, and explain what they mean.

Astronomy Merit Badge: Prerequisite requirement 7B: Sketch the phase and the daily position of the Moon at the same hour and place, for a week. Include landmarks on the horizon such as hills, trees and buildings. Explain the changes you observe. Cost \$ 60.00 Limit 20 boys **Early Bird Discount: Register before Sept 9: \$50**

Aviation Merit Badge: Prerequisite requirement 4: Do ONE of the following:

a. Visit an airport. After the visit, report on how the facilities are used, how runways are numbered, and how runways are determined to be "active."

b. Visit a Federal Aviation Administration facility—a control tower, terminal radar control facility, air route traffic control center, flight service station, or Flight Standards District Office. (Phone directory listings are under U.S. Government Offices, Transportation Department, Federal Aviation Administration. Call in advance.) Report on the operation and your impressions of the facility.

c. Visit an aviation museum or attend an air show. Report on your impressions of the museum or show.
